DG ENVI Consultation on indicators to measure resource efficiency in the building sector

In July 2014, the European Commission released the Communication on Resource Efficiency Opportunities in the Building Sector - COM (2014)445. The Communication identifies the need for a common EU framework of indicators to assess the environmental performance of buildings to be developed by 2017. The first set of indicators was proposed by the JRC in a study published recently and put under public consultation by DG Environment.

The outcome of the consultation will be presented at the second stakeholder working group meeting organised in Brussels on 30/11/2016. The findings from both, the consultation and the stakeholder working group meeting, will then be used to inform preparation of the final framework of core indicators. REHVA will prepare comments during the consultation process.

CEN/CENELEC sector forum on Financing tools for energy efficiency

REHVA joined a forum coordinated by CEN on Financing tools for energy efficiency. The aim of the forum is to assess existing standards that can help to boost private and public investment in energy efficient construction projects.

The working group will analyse standards, and protocols to de-risk energy efficiency investments following a holistic approach and elaborate recommendation on new, enabling tools (i.e. standards, procedures, best practice templates) to ensure standardised technical and financial processes for each steps to minimise risk and increase the confidence of investors.

CEN-EPB standards, Formal Vote approaching, read more from REHVA Journal 4/2016

CEN and ISO have agreed to send out all the 52 EPB standards simultaneously for formal vote by 31 October 2016. The voting deadline will then be two months later, by 31 December 2016. At the same time the Technical Report Voting will be held, so also probably 31 October - 31 December 2016.

The new issue of REHVA Journal, 4/2016, contains a [new update of the package](#), written by Jaap Hogeling, Chair of CEN TC 371 Program Committee on EPBD; Chair of JWG of ISO TC 163 & 205 advisory group on coordination of ISO and CEN Work on EPB.

The reason for the simultaneous voting of all final draft standards is that the standards (and TR's) refer to each other. Judging and voting the EPB standards and their interrelations is only possible if the total set is available. The voting time will be exactly two months; no extension is allowed in the CEN or ISO system even though the deadline will be during the Christmas holiday period. Everyone interested in taking position to the final drafts are recommended to contact their National Standardization Body before the end of October 2016.

Jaap Hogeling's article contains much useful information about the EPB standards - the philosophy, the essential elements of the package and the key standards, about the parallel European (CEN) and global (ISO) work, the relationships between individual standards in the package, and about the relationships between EPB standards and product standards, many of which are or will be subject to substantial revision due to the new Ecodesign regulations.

New EN ISO Standard on Air Filtration coming soon

A new global Standard EN-ISO 16980-1 "Air filters for general ventilation -- Part 1: Technical specifications, requirements and classification system based upon particulate matter efficiency (ePM)" which will replace the existing European Standard EN 779, has been subject to national position balloting until 3 August 2016. This is the final stage before the final voting. The intention of ISO has been to send all standards in the EN ISO 16980 to formal vote simultaneously.

The filter classification is going to change once again, this time there will be a total change. As a consequence, REHVA Guidebook 11 on Air Filtration will need a revision.

4 new REHVA members joining the PROF/TRAC scheme

PROF/TRAC, the Training and Qualification Platform on nZEB skills will organise its 2nd Train-the-Trainer course hosted by HKIS in Zagreb on 19-20 September 2016. Trainers and experts from AiCARR (Italy), AIIR (Romania), ETE (Hungary), and FINVAC (Finland) will join the course to learn about the preparation of new training courses in their countries in the future using the materials and methodology provided PROF/TRAC. Pilot courses were organised during the summer of 2016 by 4 REHVA members: ATECYR (Spain), DANVAC (Denmark), HKIS (Croatia) and TVVL (Netherlands).
