Tender specification - Objectives

- Technical inputs to refine & **finalize** the SRI definition and calculation **methodology**
- Test applicability on **reference buildings** representative of the EU building stock
- Explore & assess the technical modalities for an **effective implementation** of the SRI scheme
- Technical inputs for **impact assessment**
- Support the **dialogue with stakeholders and Member States**

Tender specification - Tasks

- TASK 1: Technical support for the consolidation of the definition and the calculation methodology of the SRI.
- TASK 2: Investigation of SRI implementation pathways and of the format of the SRI.
- TASK 3: Guidance for effective SRI implementation.
- TASK 4: Quantitative modelling and analysis of the impact of the SRI at EU level.
- TASK 5: Stakeholder consultation and study website.
- TASK 6: Support to the policy making process.

Tender specification - Timing

- Contract signed in December 2018
- 1st Stakeholder meeting M3: **March 2019**
- 2nd stakeholder meeting M7: **July 2019**
- 3rd stakeholder meeting M14 (**TBD**): February 2020

- 1st interim report M3: March 2019
- 2nd interim report M6: June 2019
- 3rd interim report M11: **November 2019**
- **Final report M16: April 2020**

Set-up of REHVA SRI Advocacy Group to provide inputs

Most relevant Tasks to focus on:

T1 (M1-M12): Consolidation of the definition and the calculation methodology

- Critical, targeted review of the 1st study
- Technical recommendations on the SRI definition (catalogue of smart services, compliance with recast EPBD, interoperability - data format)
- Technical recommendations on calculation methodology illustrated on a representative set of reference buildings

REHVA contribution pathways & advocacy plan

T2 (M1-M12): SRI implementation pathways and format

- Implementation options from on-site inspection to digital self-assessment by the owner or third party
- Possible connections and coupling with existing schemes
- Robust and flexible implementation pathways for the rollout

T3 (M1-M12): Guidance for effective SRI implementation

- Organizational structure
- Operational structure & additional EU/MS level support measures
