

As members of REHVA, you are committed to upholding the highest standards of professionalism, integrity, and ethical behaviour in all our activities. This Code provides a framework for members to guide their conduct in promoting excellence within the field of building services engineering and beyond.

Members shall:

Uphold Professionalism and Public Interest:

Conduct themselves in a manner that upholds the dignity and reputation of the profession and the Federation, safeguarding the public interest in matters relevant to the art, science, and practice of building services engineering.

Exercise Competence and Diligence

Perform their duties with skill, care, and diligence, discharging responsibilities faithfully and in line with professional standards. Members shall only undertake work for which they have the necessary technical competence and resources and disclose any relevant limitations.

Maintain and Advance Competence

Actively pursue continuing professional development by enhancing and broadening their knowledge and skills. Members should also encourage others to maintain their competence.

Reject Corruption and Promote Transparency

Reject bribery, fraud, and all forms of corrupt behaviour. Members must take positive steps to ensure others, including colleagues and collaborators, also adhere to these principles.

Avoid Conflicts of Interest

Avoid real or perceived conflicts of interest wherever possible. Any significant interests that may affect impartiality must be disclosed to employers, clients, or relevant parties.

Embrace Equality, Diversity, and Fair Treatment

Treat all persons with fairness, respect, and dignity. Members must actively support equality of opportunity and diversity, eliminating discrimination in all forms.

Foster Collaboration

Cooperate proactively with other professionals in the built environment, fostering an integrated and multidisciplinary approach to projects.

Respect Confidentiality and Security

Adopt a security-minded approach and safeguard the confidentiality of sensitive information, intellectual property, and proprietary materials.

Act with Integrity on Behalf of the Federation

When representing REHVA, members shall act in accordance with the Federation's values, accurately represent its views, and avoid promoting personal or employer interests.

This Code is intended to guide members in achieving the highest levels of ethical practice and professionalism, reflecting REHVA's commitment to advancing the built environment sustainably and responsibly across Europe and globally.
