

Benzene: Leukemia


PM: cardiovascular diseases

VOC \biological pollutants: Respiratory illness, asthma and allergies




Significance of Health Effects

- BUMA: Prioritization of Building Materials as indoor pollution sources
- HealthyAir: Network for actions and activities that address the effect of construction product on indoor air
- HESEINT: Interventions on Health Effects of Health Environments
- GERI: Geriatric study in Europe on health effects of air quality in nursing homes
- **RADPAR:** Radon prevention and remediation
- Indoor–Expo: update of index priority compounds, PM inclusion, criteria for monitoring requirements

IAQ Expert Group

✓Work plan: building & equipments and occupants

Thematic meetings on: constructions, damp and moisture

✓ Design and construction of a website for public and professional



✓ International agreement on Key pollutants based on health effects

✓ Health based guidelines on key pollutants (WHO)

✓ Criteria for monitoring indoor air Vs health effects (JRC)

✓Tool for awareness increasing public and professionals (Website)

✓ Feasibility of common criteria for existing labelling schemes in EU

✓ Construction material emission database and guidance

✓ Studies targeted to most vulnerable groups (children, elderly)

MS support (e.g. radon, ventilation, moisture and dampness)

✓ Identification of source and recommendation for actions (ENVIE)
